

## 希臘文進階解經／釋經 Greek Exegesis

課程名稱：Greek Exegesis of Ephesians 用希臘文解讀以弗所書

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### I. 導言 Introduction

#### A. 課程簡介 Course description

將進行以弗所書的希臘文解經，目的乃是使我們更了解以弗所書，並發展用希臘文解釋新約經文的技巧。主題將包括單詞研究、高級語法的使用、修辭分析、保羅神學，並且與舊約主題相連的研究。Exegesis of Ephesians in the Greek text, with the goal of better understanding Ephesians and developing skill in exegeting texts in the Greek New Testament. Topics include word study, use of advanced grammars, rhetorical analysis, Pauline theology, and research on topical connections with the Old Testament.

#### B. 學習目標 Learning goals

在課程結束前，學生應該能夠：By the end of the course, the student should be able to:

1. 證明有使用希臘文辭典的能力 Demonstrate skill in using Greek lexicons
2. 證明有使用希臘文文法的能力 Demonstrate skill in using Greek grammars
3. 對一段希臘文進行修辭分析 Do a rhetorical analysis of a passage in Greek
4. 更熟悉希臘文詞彙，增進希臘文閱讀能力，以及識別文法結構的能力。Show an increase in Greek vocabulary, in Greek reading, and in ability to identify grammatical constructions
5. 研究與舊約相關的主題 Research topical connections with the Old Testament

### II. 評分 Grading

本課程的評分將基於三方面：(1) 課程的參與，包括指定解經問題的簡短報告。(2) 半小時的是非題期末考；(3) 在歌羅西書當中挑選一部分進行修辭分析。功課繳交期限：2019年八月一日下午4:30，提交給改革宗神學院教務處。Grading will be based on three contributions: (1) class participation, including short reports on assigned exegetical problems; (2) 1/2 hour T/F final exam; and (3) a rhetorical analysis of a selected portion in Colossians. The rhetorical analysis is due at 4:30pm, Taiwan time, at CRTS, on Aug. 1, 2019.
